EDUSAVE CHARACTER AWARD (ECHA)

ECHA has been introduced by the Ministry of Education since 2012 as part of the larger goal to foster an inclusive and stronger Singapore as we broaden the qualities and achievements to be encouraged and applauded.

The objectives of the Edusave Character Award are:

- 1. To send a clear and strong signal of the importance that MOE places on character and values, on par with achievements in the academic domain; and
- 2. To recognise outstanding students in each school who are exemplary in character, and who can be role models to inspire others.

In Chongfu school, nominees for the ECHA should fulfil the following:

- 1. The nominee is a Singapore citizen.
- 2. The nominee must, on a consistent basis, demonstrate good character and values.
- 3. The nominee demonstrates the following types of qualities:
 - a) Our school values of **GRACIOUSLY** and/or,
 - b) Resilience and/or
 - c) Civic Responsibility and/or
 - d) School Pride.

Students who meet the above-mentioned criteria can be nominated for this award by their parents, teachers and coaches. Shortlisted nominees will then complete a personal reflection and attend an interview before endorsement by our school leaders.
